\$1000 Undergraduate Student Member Scholarship

The Association of the Chemical Profession of British Columbia (ACPBC) Undergraduate Student Scholarship, in the amount of \$1000, is awarded annually to an ACPBC student member enrolled in third or fourth year of an undergraduate Chemistry program at a British Columbia university. All applicants should be student members of the ACPBC. The award is equally based on academic performance in all completed Chemistry courses and service to the Chemistry profession.

Application deadline: October 21, 2011

Award announcement: November 30, 2011

Application Requirements:

1. **Student membership in the ACPBC.** There is no charge for student Membership. An Application form is available at the ACPBC web site (www.pchembc.ca) and requires a current official student transcript. The application may be made concurrently with the scholarship application.
2. **Service to the profession:** Applicants must include a one page letter documenting Chemistry activities in which they have been involved; these may include participating in National Chemistry Week, IYC events, Open Houses, Chemistry shows, mentoring and Science camps, for example. Contact information for two references to corroborate the student involvement must be included.
